



The Wisconsin DNR, along with local area fishing instructors, will be holding the 7th Annual Learn-To-Fish Musky event on Friday, August 6th 2021 at the Boulder Junction Community Center located at 5392 Park Street Boulder Junction, WI 54512.

The event is open to individuals 12 years of age and up, geared toward those with little to no musky fishing experience that have always wanted to try reeling in one of Wisconsin's most popular fish. The event will start at 8:00 AM with classroom lessons aimed toward musky identification, biology, and fishing techniques. Lunch will be provided to all registered participants and mentors.

Following classroom lessons, participants will then hit the water with local fishing mentors for a chance to catch musky. The event is being held free of charge to participants, with the exception that all participants engaged in fishing will be required to possess a valid Wisconsin fishing license. Participants will be provided with all the necessary equipment and boat to fish.
