General Information

PADDLE: 3K canoe, kayak or SUP on Boulder Lake
BIKE: 22K along paved rustic paved roads
RUN: 6K on rustic roads & wooded trails

Divisions and Awards:

- *In 2022, we will not be creating separate divisions for canoe, kayak or SUP. You may use the watercraft of your choice, but all entrants will be competing in the same divisions as listed below.*
- Individuals, ages 15-70+: Medals will be awarded to the top two males and top two females in each of the following age categories: 15-19; 20-29; 30-39; 40-49; 50-59, 60-69, 70+ in each category: Kayak, Canoe or SUP. Award plaques will be presented to the top male and top female overall in each division.
- 2 Person Teams: Divisions are male/male, female/female and co-ed in tandem kayak or tandem canoe. Each team member in each of the top finishing divisions will be presented with an award plaque and the runner-up team members in each division will be awarded a medal
- 3-Person Relay: three people will each complete one leg of the course. A plaque for each member of the top relay team will be awarded and the runner-up team members will be awarded a medal.
- ALL athletes finishing the race will receive a participation medal.

Registration Fee: Early Bird – January 4-January 31: \$75 individual, \$150 2-person team or \$170 3-person relay team.
Standard Rate – February 1 thru May 20: \$85 individual, \$170 2-person team or \$180 3-person relay team.
Online registration is open until May 19 and on-site registration is open at packet pick-up on Friday May 20.

Check-in/Package Pick-up & Walk-in Registration: Located at the Boulder Junction Community Center, 5392 Park St. Friday, May 20, 2022 from 5pm-8:30pm. Racers will pick-up their race packet and ask questions about the course and event.

Mandatory Items: Participants must wear **PFD'S** during the entire paddling leg of this event. **Helmets** must be worn during the entire biking leg of the event. **NO REFUNDS OR TRANSFERS FOR ANY REASON, INCLUDING RACE CANCELLATION OR DISQUALIFICATION**

Shuttles: Buses will run from the Community Center & the Chamber Office parking lots from 7:30am-9:30am on race day for racers.

Race Begins: Saturday, May 21, 2022 at 9am at Boulder Lake boat landing in waves of 15-20 triathletes every 5 minutes.

Race Ends: Boulder Junction Community Center at approximately 1pm.

Lunch & Awards Ceremony: Located at the Boulder Junction Community Center between 11am-3pm. Food served from 11am-2pm with music. Awards ceremony begins at 1:30pm or after the last racer crosses the finish line, whichever is earlier.

WAIVER - READ CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING: In consideration of the acceptance of my application for the entry in the White Deer Triathlon, I hereby waive, release, and discharge any and all rights or claims for damages for death, person injury, property damage or any other actions, which I (my heirs, executors and administrators) may have, which may hereafter accrue to me, as a result of my participation in said event. This release is intended to discharge in advance the promoters, the sponsors, the land owners, the Volunteers, Camp Manito-wish YMCA, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources or other business entities involved in hosting any part of the triathlon and any involved municipalities (Boulder Junction Chamber of Commerce, the Town of Boulder Junction, or any of their officers, members, sponsors, agents, or representatives), or other public entities (and their respective agents and employees), from and against any and all liability arising out of or connected in any way with my participation in said event, even though that liability may arise out of negligence or carelessness on the part of the person (s) or entities mentioned above or arising out of traveling to, participating in or returning from the White Deer Triathlon.

I further understand that serious accidents occasionally occur during triathlon events and that as a consequence thereof. Knowing the risks of triathlon events, nevertheless I hereby agree to assume those risks, and to release and to hold harmless all of the persons or entities mentioned above who (through negligence or carelessness) might otherwise be liable to me (or my heirs or assigns) for damages. It is further understood and agreed that this waiver, release and assumption of risk is to be binding on my heirs and assigns. I have also read and understand the rules and regulations set forth by the White Deer Triathlon and understand failure to follow the rules/regulations will result in disqualification. I consider myself adequately trained for this event. I further agree that I have read and will comply with the online rules, course descriptions and other criteria of this event. For relay teams, the captain signs on behalf of the team that the team will abide by the rules and regulations of this event. Each team member must sign the waiver before participating in the event. These waivers will be available at the Check-in/Package pick-up on Friday night.

In the event of an emergency, I hereby consent to receive medical treatment, which may be deemed advisable in the event of injury, accident and/or illness during the event. This AWRL shall be construed broadly to provide release and waiver to the maximum extent permissible under the applicable law. I grant the Boulder Junction Chamber of Commerce permission to contact me via email with future information regarding this and other Boulder Junction events and promotions. By registering in this event, your email will be shared with other regional triathlon partners. I grant permission to the event organizers of the Boulder Junction White Deer Triathlon to use my name, image, and photographs, videos, or any other record of my participation in the event for race commercial purposes including but not limited to newspaper, website, brochures, fliers, radio, and television.
