

## 9th Annual Boulder Junction Lions Club Walleye Classic Rules

- Registration is Saturday, Oct. 5<sup>th</sup>, 2024 at 9:00am at the Boulder Junction Community Center.
- This will be a catch and release tournament.
- Walleye Classic Hours: Saturday fishing 10am-6pm; Sunday fishing 7am-4pm
- Awards will be for the total number of inches of walleye registered for both days.
- Each team will receive 6 tickets each day with the team's number to record their catch.
- Only 5 fish per team each day will count toward the award total.
- The 6<sup>th</sup> ticket can be used to as a bonus ticket each day to <u>replace</u> any one of the fish already registered.
- Each fish must be registered by phone and emailed to <a href="macooa@centurytel.net">macooa@centurytel.net</a> or texted by phone to <a href="macooa@centurytel.net">715-892-1204</a> which includes your name and ticket #.
- Your phones must have the time/date/location turned on. Any photo received without these items will be disqualified.
- The entire walleye being measured with the team number on your bump board showing the length of the walleye to ¼ inch must show in the photo. The nose of the fish at the beginning of the bump board and the tail should be pinched at the end. Please check your photo that we can see the entire fish before sending and releasing the fish in case you need another photo. Minimum length of 12" required for registration.
- Release on the water after taking the photo and checking the photo. Then text to 715-892-1204 or email to <a href="macooa@centurytel.net">macooa@centurytel.net</a>.
- If you do not have good cell reception, take an accurate photo of the fish and release it, then move to an area that has cell reception. All photos must be received by the end of day time.
- You can only use one Bonus ticket per day. All tickets are dated as Saturday or Sunday.
- The team should also keep a record on your tally sheet to keep track of your walleyes registered and compare with Laura before dinner. She will try to reply to your emails and confirm that she has the information on your fish.
- All fish registered by phone at Walleye Classic base will be recorded on a master tally sheet.
- Fish photos and tally sheet will be reviewed for accuracy.
- No fish will be recorded before or after tournament fishing hours.
- Not responsible for photos that are not clearly depicting the whole fish measurement.
- Special Rules: Any lakes in Boulder Junction Township can be fished as long as a phone connection is available. All teams must have cell phones capable of transmitting photos of fish to Walleye Classic computer at <a href="macooa@centurytel.net">macooa@centurytel.net</a> or text to 1-715-892-1204.
- In case of a tie after the two days, the single largest fish of the tied anglers will determine the winner. After that if there is still a tie, the earliest recorded time for the 1<sup>st</sup> fish for the two teams will be the winner.

- Dinner & Awards: 5:00pm on Sunday, October 6<sup>th</sup>, 2024 at The Outdoorsman Restaurant & Tavern, Main St. Boulder Junction, WI followed by the awards & raffle at 6pm.
- Prize money is based on 10 teams participating & will be prorated if less than 10 teams enter.
